NHS Ayrshire & Arran is developing a new National Treatment Centre (NTC) close to University Hospital Ayr on what was the previous Carrick Glen Hospital site. The National Treatment Centre will provide capacity for elective orthopaedic surgery (which includes operations like hip and knee replacements).



We want to make sure that the new National Treatment Centre is as beneficial as possible for patients, visitors, staff, the local community, and the environment.

We are holding a drop-in event on **31 October from 2.30pm – 5pm at Ayr Town Hall** to share information and hear from members of the public about the proposals.



The event will use a tool called the 'Place Standard', which was developed in Scotland to gather community views about a specific place and give local people an opportunity to discuss the design and share what aspects would be important to them in this new National Treatment Centre.

Refreshments will be provided and the venue is fully accessible.
