# What support can you access from services at Compass?

- Drop-in support
- Support from someone with lived experience
- Seeing services under one roof
- Central place for support following liberation from prison or discharge from hospital
- → Rapid support
- → Signposting and support to access other services
- Crisis Interventions
- → Access to alcohol and drug treatment services, who provide alcohol detox's and opiate substitute therapy

- Advice and support relating to drug and alcohol use
- Harm reduction advice, Injecting Equipment Provision, Naloxone supply, BBV testing, Wound care
- Relapse prevention support
- → Advice and support in relation to basic Universal Credit
- Independent advocacy support
- Housing advice and support including homelessness
